**ENROLLMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING AT NAVAL SHIP REPAIR YARD**  
**NAVAL BASE, KARWAR, KARNATAKA - 681 308 (01/2018 BATCH)**

1. Applications are invited from ITI qualified Indian citizens (both male/female) for Apprenticeship training in the following designated trades for a period of One Year/Six Months at Dockyard Apprentices School, NSRY, Karwar as per the Apprentices Act 1961 (amended from time to time):-

**Note:** No. of vacancies mentioned above may increase or decrease depending on the requirements & prevailing Govt. rules.

2. **Eligibility Conditions.** Candidate qualified in one / two year ITI (SCVT or NCVT) in respective trades only need to apply. Those who have already given ITI final exams and awaiting for results may also apply. However, they are to meet the minimum qualifying marks as mentioned below and should submit original mark sheets during the document verification / Interview. Candidates who have already undergone or undergoing apprenticeship training under Apprentices Act, 1961 in any other Govt. / Public Sector / Private Industrial organization are not eligible to apply. Candidate should also meet:-

(a) **Educational Qualification.** Candidates scored above 50% marks in SSLO/Matriculation/ X<sup>th</sup> class or equivalent and above 65% marks in the ITI (SCVT or NCVT)

(b) **Age.** Candidates should have completed 14 years and below 21 years of age as on 01 Apr 2018. Upper age limit of 21 years is relaxable for SC/ST/PwD's/Ex-Servicemen / Wards of Ex-servicemen and other notified categories as per Govt. rules in force.

(c) Physical Standards. Physical standards should be in accordance with the Apprentices Act, 1961 and should be satisfying minimum standards as mentioned below:-

For Male: Height minimum - 150 cms, Weight minimum - 45 Kgs, Chest Expansion - 5 cms and Eye Sight 6/6 to 6/9 (6/9 corrected with glasses).

For Female: Height minimum - 137 cms, Weight minimum - 25.4 Kgs and Eye Sight 6/6 to 6/9 (6/9 corrected with glasses)..

Candidates should be medically fit and external/ Internal organs normal. Medical examination shall be conducted at Karwar for the qualified candidates.

3. Reservation and Age relaxation. Reservation of seats and age relaxation as per existing Government rules and regulations and provisions contained in Apprentices Act, 1961 shall be applicable.

4. Stipend. As per Govt. of India notification. At present, selected candidates are paid eighty/ninety percent of minimum wage of semi-skilled workers as notified by the Govt. of Karnataka / NCVT guidelines (Rs. 8320/- to Rs. 9360/- per month as on 01 Jul 2017).

5. Last date. Last date for receipt of application at DAS, NSRY, Karwar within 30 days of publication of this notification in Employment Newspaper.

6. How to apply:-

Step 1: Interested eligible candidates are required to register online through NCVT MIS web portal ([www.apprenticeship.gov.in](http://www.apprenticeship.gov.in)). The process for registration is as below:-

NCVT MIS Homepage ([www.apprenticeship.gov.in](http://www.apprenticeship.gov.in)) > Apprenticeship > Apprentices > Apprentice Registration > Submit application > Apprentice Activation > Activate > A new mail will be triggered to the registered email ID with Apprentice Registration number > Print the registration form and note down apprentice registration number.

Step 2: Candidates meeting the educational, age and other qualification mentioned above are to prepare an application on white paper furnishing candidates name, apprentice registration number, gender, trade applied for, Date of Birth, reservation category, marks obtained in SSLC/Matriculation & ITI, Aadhar number, contact number, email id, with candidate signature and along with two copies of apprentice registration form & three coloured passport size photographs is to be forwarded to "The Officer-in-Charge, Dockyard Apprentice School, NSRY, Naval Base PO, Karwar, Karnataka - 581 308". Application received after due date and incomplete application will be rejected and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

Step 3: Candidates shall receive an instruction sheet / call letter for written exam on their email id. Candidates are to print that call letter received on their email id. They are to appear for the written examination on the scheduled day at Naval Base, Karwar along with printed call letter, apprentice registration form, original mark sheet of SSLC/Matriculation & ITI, original certificates for reservation category and character certificate. Candidate not in possession of listed documents or not meeting the eligibility conditions shall not be selected for apprenticeship training even though they may qualify in written examination.

7. Selection Procedure. A call letter for written examination will be issued to all eligible candidates on their registered email ID. Written examination would be objective type based on Mathematics, General Science and General Knowledge. No TA/DA will be paid for written examination. A merit list shall be prepared on the basis of written examination. Candidates in the order of merit would be called for document verification / interview in various trades and applicable reservation categories. Candidates cleared in document verification / interview will have to undergo medical examination. Only those candidates called for document verification / interview will be paid second class train fare from home / journey station to Karwar on production of original railway / bus

ticket. Candidates qualifying written test are to sufficiently be prepared to accommodate themselves at their own arrangements for 3-4 days in case of spillover of interview and medical examination.

8. Apprenticeship Contract. Finally selected candidates shall be offered apprenticeship contract as per the Apprentices Act, 1961 and they are to join DAS, NSRY, Karwar on the mentioned date (likely to be on 01 Apr 2018).

9. Hostel. Limited hostel accommodation (for boys only) is available on first come first serve and merit basis for outstation candidates.

10. No Obligation. As per Apprentices Act, 1961 read in conjunction with Apprentices (Amendment) Act 2014 and Apprenticeship Rules - 2015, it shall not be obligatory for NSRY, Karwar or any other Govt. agency to employ Apprentices on completion of apprenticeship training. There are no provisions for providing direct employment in NSRY, Karwar or any other Govt. agency on completion of apprenticeship training.

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
